



Judge H. B. "Scott" Watts

Judge Scott Watts is a 1975 graduate of the University of Georgia with a Bachelor's Degree in Political Science and graduated in 1986 from the University of Georgia School of Law, where he worked with the Athens Legal Aid Defender Society, and with Volunteer Income Tax Assistance. After law school, Judge Watts served for two years as a law clerk for the Superior Court Judges in Clayton County. In 1989, Judge Watts worked with a law firm in Jonesboro, until he and his wife founded their own law firm, Watts & Watts. Judge Watts has served as an associate judge of the Magistrate Court since 1998. Judge Watts regularly sits as a municipal court judge in several Clayton County cities and sits as a judge in the Probate Court. He is a past president of the Clayton County Bar Association, recipient of the bar association's Tradition of Excellence Award, and was recently elected a member of the Board of Governors of the State Bar of Georgia. Judge Watts lives with his wife in Jonesboro.
